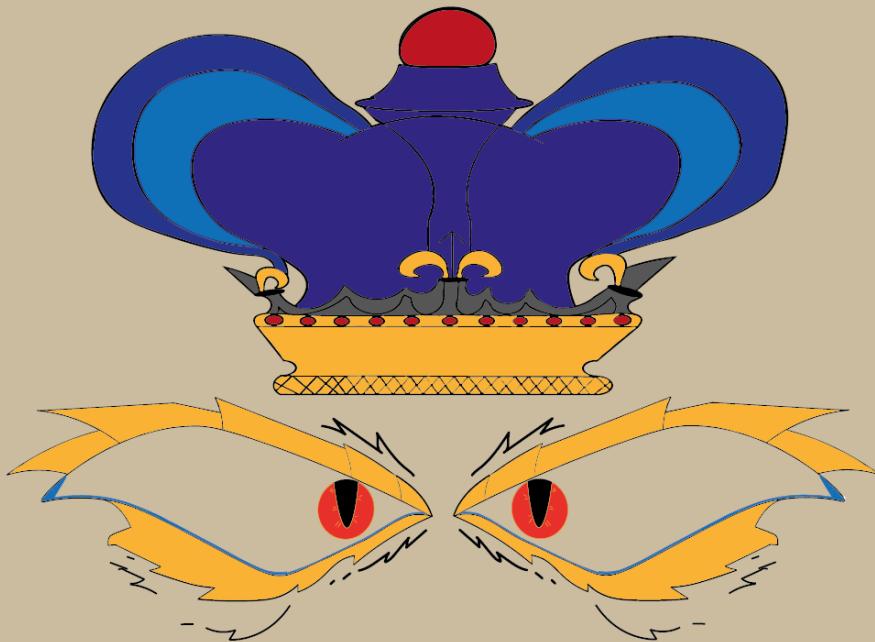

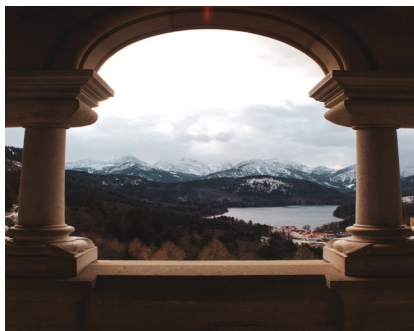

Watching Abbie training Egon gives me chills to see them train together and know they are the very well protective over their loved ones.

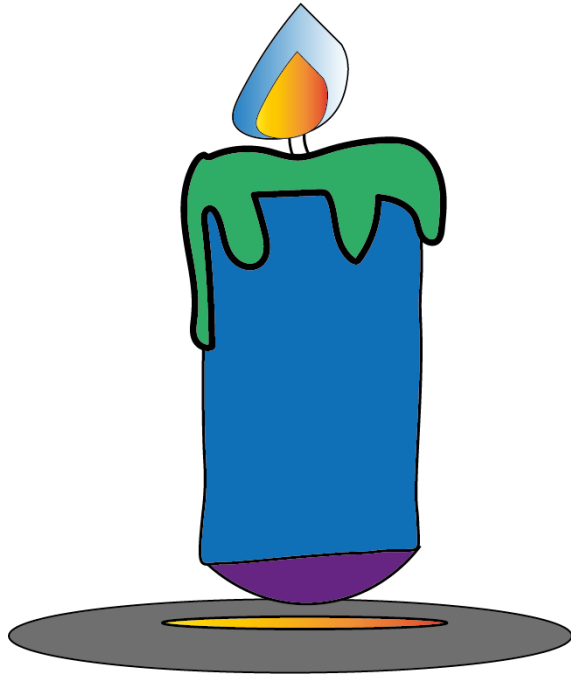
“Do you know now what you must do?” said John giving me a hand to stand up.
